- [d] Beechwood Avenue Lower (100 homes)
- [e] Beechwood Avenue Upper (72 homes),
- [f] Ashfield Road, Ashfield Avenue, Mornington Road (136 homes)
- [g] Anna Villa, Beechwood Road (76 homes)
