The Future of Irish Catholicism

In his recent pastoral letter (March 2017) the Bishop of Ardagh and Clonmacnoise, Francis Duffy, advised parishioners: "As our priests retire or are transferred, there will not be priests to replace them and so an increasing number of parishes will not have a resident priest, or if you have, then your priest may be called to provide pastoral care in a neighbouring parish that is without a resident priest.

This ongoing development will impact every parish in the diocese and will bring about considerable change in how the parishes are organised and also in the way the Good News of Jesus Christ is passed on to succeeding generations."
