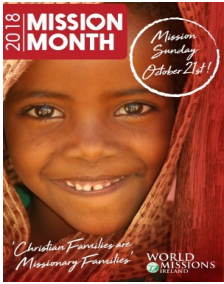

Mission Month October 2018

October is Mission Month. The most important day of this month is World Mission Sunday which takes place on the 21st. This is the one Sunday in the year that Pope Francis asks you to pray a little stronger and dig a little deeper so that faith, hope and love can flourish. Contributions given on World Mission Sunday will support the fearless and selfless work of our missionaries, who live shoulder to shoulder with people in communities that are struggling and often war-torn.

World Mission Sunday is coordinated by 'World Missions Ireland', officially known as the Pontifical Mission Societies. It is the Church's official charity for overseas missions and is part of a worldwide network of over 120 charities.

Next Sunday, October 21st, Pope Francis is asking you and every Catholic worldwide to come together in celebration of World Mission Sunday. On this very special day every Church, in every parish across the world will give what they can, no matter how little, towards the World Mission Sunday collection. Your contribution will be used to help spread faith, hope and love by supporting overseas missionaries, many of whom work in some of the world's most impoverished and remote communities.

The second collection at all Masses next weekend is for World Mission Sunday and replaces the Share collection.
